INSTRUCTIONS MILITARY SALUTES INSIDE THE PRISONER OF WAR CAMP

- I. The Military Salute must be given to every sentry on duty in the camp. Being uncovered, pass at attention and the head should be turned right or left, as the case may be.
- II. Whenever a sentry enters a house or a block attention must be called by "kiotsuke" by the man who first sees the sentry enter the premises.
- III. Leaders of working parties must order "Kashira Migi" or "Hidari" as the case may be.
- IV. A group of prisoners engaged in their allotted tasks (such as gardening, basketweavers, gutters detail and other work) salute the Japanese Camp Commander only.
- V. Salutes as mentioned under I, II and III also have to be given to Shimohara San, Okubo San, Notomi San, Yoshida San and the Sergeant of the Guard.
